

Breaking News Seniors wins in the budget

The recent 2024/25 Federal Budget addresses several key cost-of-living concerns for seniors, highlighting the impact of National Seniors Australia's advocacy. Notable measures include a \$300 energy bill rebate, a 10% increase in Commonwealth Rent Assistance, and a 12-month freeze on deeming rates. These initiatives aim to alleviate financial pressures on seniors, reflecting the importance of your ongoing support and engagement in our advocacy campaigns.

Additional budget provisions for seniors encompass tax cuts, health benefits, and aged care reforms. Taxpayers, including many aged 50+, will see reductions in tax rates. Health measures include a freeze on PBS co-payment indexation and increased thresholds for Medicare levy exemptions. The aged care sector will benefit from significant investments, including \$2.2 billion for ongoing reforms, enhanced digital systems, additional home care packages, and continued funding for dementia and palliative care programs. These comprehensive changes underscore the government's commitment to improving the quality of life for seniors.
