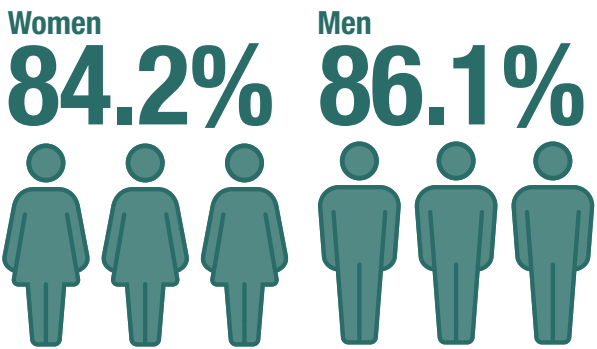




Older Australians and climate change 2021

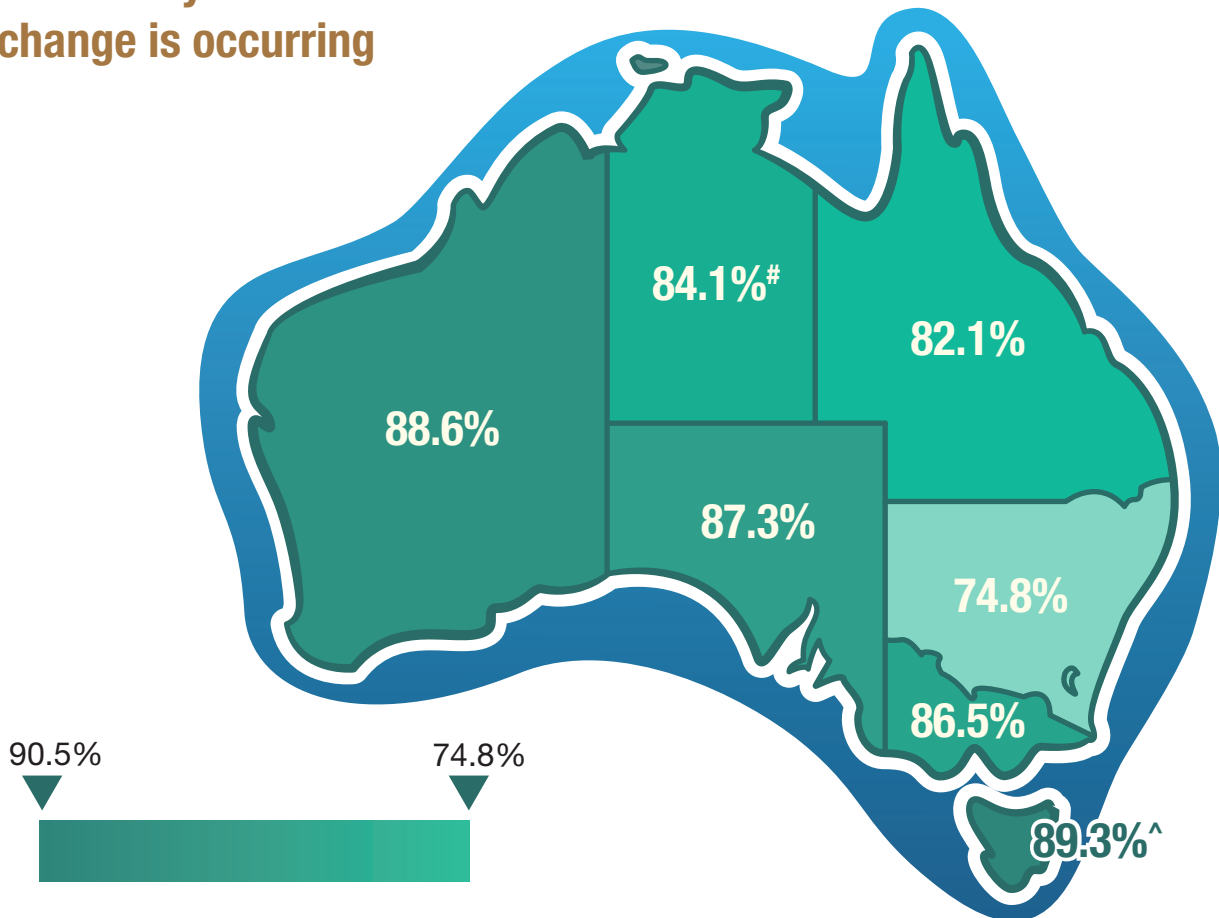
