RECIPE:

4 INGREDIENT FRUIT CAKE

1kg Mixed Fruit

- 2 cups pure fresh orange juice
- 2 cups self-raising flour
- 1 teas cinnamon

Soak fruit in orange juice overnight. Preheat oven 150deg.(130 fan forced). Line 20cm round cake pan with baking paper and spray with cooking spray. Mix fruit mixture, flour and cinnamon. Spoon into prepared tin. Bake 30mins or till cooked through. Remove and cool. Spread with apricot jam, top with toasted almonds and dust with icing sugar if desired.
