SEPTEMBER

Our much anticipated away trip to the New South Wales area of Bellingen/Dorrigo is now sadly the victim of COVID-19 for the second year running. It grieves me to report that after consultation with Allan Foster of 'Granite Highlands Maxi Tours' the Management Committee has had to cancel this away trip. It will be reviewed for a suitable date next year hopefully at a time when COVID-19 is not of concern.

Finding places to go is becoming increasingly difficult especially for quality away trips to locations we have not ventured before. To this end I have developed a three-day two night away trip to Tewantin and Noosa. This trip focuses on the Noosa River and surrounds with two nights in a resort by the Marina.
