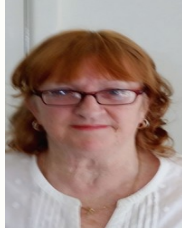




August 2019

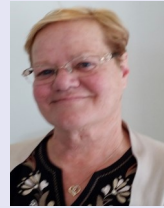
September is our Annual General Meeting. All positions are open, please give some thought to joining the Committee. Perhaps come along to our August committee meeting and check out the system.
