

Carols Corner Changing the World One story at a Time This month's contribution was written by a friend of Carol's and Carol thought it would be of interest to Broadbeach Seniors. So, here are her words.



As I celebrated Australia Day there was a sense of sadness during this day.

As a woman born in 1979, I have endured incidents of reverse racism, bigotry and virtue signalling on several occasions over my school, work and lifetime.
