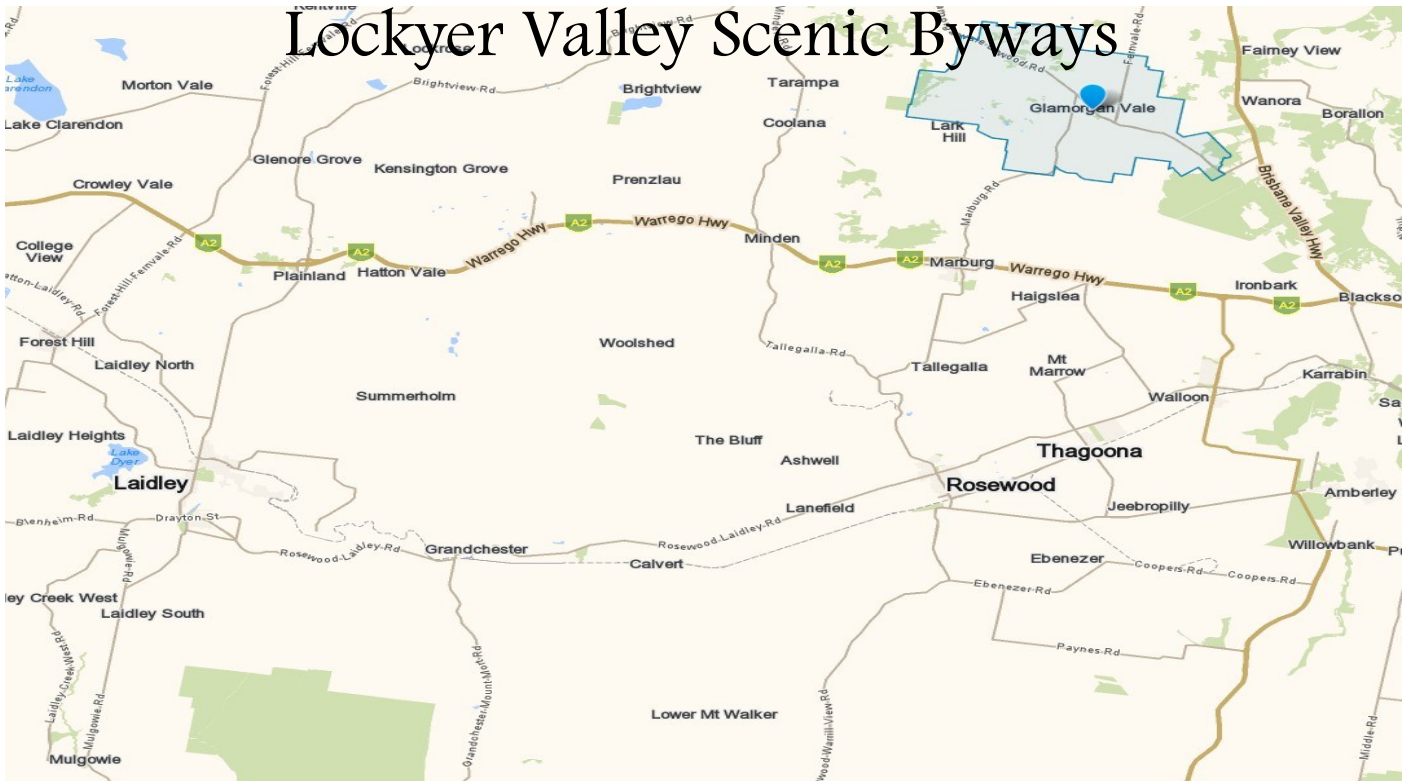


Carindale National Seniors Bus Trip
