Day 1 CANBERRA TO CAMDEN VALLEY **Tuesday 28 April** (LD), Bus pick up in Canberra then we head through the Southern Highlands to our destination of Thirlmere. Visiting the Heritage Rail Centre, we'll discover how the NSW railways brought life to town and country. Marvel at the engineering and design achievements and walk the timeline of rail development from steam powered engine to the revolutionised leisure travel we have today. Following lunch we continue through to Camden to explore the main street, and the museum, which has a marvellous collection showing just what it was like to live here when the area was first settled. Arriving at the refurbished Camden Valley Inn we'll be impressed by its quaint charm and country friendliness. (Lunch and dinner)

Day 2 EXPLORING CAMDEN VALLEY **Wednesday 29 April** We are joined on the coach by a local specialist for a morning tour of the Camden Valley area. The rural beauty and history shared will give us a greater understanding of the development of this area. For another glimpse of a bygone era, we visit Wivenhoe Historic Home. One of the first homes in the colony, it was surrounded by the fields of the Macarthur region. It has been added to over the years but continues to hold significant heritage value. We stay for lunch before driving through the valley to Wollondilly Heritage Centre. We'll be given a unique insight into the history of the area as well as a delicious afternoon tea served on the shady verandah. After we explore the many exhibitions on offer we continue out to Burragorang lookout. High above Warragamba Dam, the lookout provides us with impressive views overlooking New South Wales' most precious water resource. (BLD)

Day 3 SONGS OF THE 60s **Thursday 30 April** We're on our way to Windsor this morning for a fun-filled and entertaining day. Starting with a lovely morning tea we'll take our seats for the live show. From our easy vantage point, our toes will be tapping in no time whilst singing along to the Hits of the 60s with our entertainer. A delicious lunch is enjoyed as we listen to all our favourite songs from the era, and maybe even have a dance or two! Boarding the coach taking us back to Camden Valley, we have time to reminisce about the good old days humming as we recollect wonderful memories. (BLD)

Day 4 CAMDEN TO CANBERRA March **Friday 1 May** Farewelling Camden, we load the coach and make our way through to Mount Annan Botanic Gardens. This is the native plant garden of the Royal Botanic Gardens, displaying a huge diversity of Australian flora. Listening to our guide, we'll discover more about the rainforest, bushland and grassland gardens including the many species of birds that call this place home. Heading for home we'll break for a light lunch in the Southern Highlands, finishing off our relaxed tour. We arrive in Canberra having had a truly memorable and gentle-paced tour. (BL)
