Introducing Merissa Craft guest speaker and owner of Paragon Theatre & Espresso Bar.

Leaving Childers at 17, Merissa Ricciardi (now Craft) embarked on an adventurous journey, living in various places across Australia, including Melbourne. Her travels extended beyond the borders, as she lived in London and backpacked overseas in her 20s.

At the age of 23, she purchased The Paragon from her grandparents, Charlie (Carmelo) and Marietta Ricciardi, and began an incredible and challenging journey of restoration. Over the past 18 years, Merissa has meticulously restored the building from front to back, transforming it into a vibrant hub of activity.

Returning to the region in December 2011, she embraced life's ups and downs, getting married, having her beautiful children, and eventually getting divorced. As a dedicated single mum for the last six years, she lives on-site with her three wonderful children: twin girls, Evie and Ava (8 years old), and her son, Eli (11 years old).

In July 2014, she proudly reopened The Paragon as an entertainment venue, breathing new life into the community. Her entrepreneurial spirit didn't stop there; in November 2015, she launched the Espresso Bar, followed by The Perfectly Imperfect Collective in May 2025. Her commitment to preservation and excellence was recognized in 2015 when she and her exhusband won a National Trust award for their outstanding conservation work.

Through it all, she has remained resilient and passionate, continuously contributing to her community and creating spaces that inspire and connect people.



National advocacy update



Pension indexation & deeming changes from 20 September

From 20 September 2025, Age Pension payments will rise by up to \$29.70 for singles and \$22.40 each for couples—the largest increase in two years. At the same time, deeming rates will lift by 0.5%, meaning some pensioners may see their increase offset.

The government timed the deeming rate change with indexation to soften the impact, a move NSA strongly advocated for. Our advocacy was recognised when Minister for Social Services, Tanya Plibersek, personally briefed CEO Chris Grice ahead of the announcement. NSA will continue discussions with the Minister ahead of March 2026 indexation. We continue to call for a fairer, more transparent way to set deeming rates and better support for pensioners facing cost-of-living pressures.

Aged care: A step in right direction

The Federal Government will release 20,000 new Home Care Packages before 1 November, with a total of 83,000 to be delivered by mid-2026. This announcement marks progress toward reducing the long wait list that has left tens of thousands of older Australians without support. NSA has strongly advocated for this action, emphasising the human cost of delays on both older people and their families. While challenges remain, this decision is an important step toward ensuring older Australians can age safely at home, as recommended by the Royal Commission.
