CNSA First Monthly Meeting for 2020 – Tuesday January 28th from 10.30am

Do you have any questions about your Centrelink entitlements or pension? Margie Horstman, from the Department of Human Services, will be the guest speaker at our monthly meeting on January 28. She provides the Financial Information Service, Face to Face Services for Northern Queensland. Margie will discuss pension entitlements and explain access to concession cards so that you receive discounts on prescriptions, electricity bills, concessions on council rates. cheaper car registration and save on public transport fares. She will explain in simple words what the questions on the pension application form mean. Margie will talk about how the age pension asset test and income test work and clarify part pension rates. We hope

she can take some of the mystery out of deeming rates, franked dividends, thresholds and cut-offs.

She will explain the differences between a Pensioner Concession Card, a Low Income Health Care Card and a Commonwealth Seniors Health Care Card.

Please don't expect Margie to be able to change the system. But she can explain how the system works and you may hear of services and benefits that you do didn't know about. The meeting will be held on Tuesday January 28 at the Oak Tree Retirement Village, 40 Foulkes Street, Norman Gardens at 10.30 am.
