Commonwealth Seniors Health Card (CSHC) gives self-funded retirees access to cheaper PBS medicines and other concessions. Eligibility for the CSHC is based on income **\$90,000 a year** for **single** self-funded retirees, to **\$144,000 for couples**

Electricity Contact your retailer

If you get a bill that alarms you, don't be shy. Contact your retailer as soon as possible. Ask if you are on the best deal available. Many Australians are not.

Request assistance

If you need assistance paying a bill, let your retailer know. A shorter shower, a small adjustment to your thermostat, or using some appliances during the day instead of at night could make a big difference, especially if you have rooftop solar
