Payment is due for all travelers by the end of this month - unless you have made private arrangements at Departure Point. All travelers are covered by insurance for major health issues. To date we have 37 members to enjoy much fun and adventure.

I am requiring an assistant during the tour. This will involve looking after part of the group at the times when we must divide into 2 groups. This is a short term responsibility to assist on and off the coach, making sure the luggage is all loaded, keeping travelers as a group so members don't wander off. Please speak with BarbK today if you would like to assist, thank you. Today I have the medical forms for you to fill out and return at the next meeting. This is required only in an emergency and kept private for ambulance and medical persons only. Forms are returned to you at the end of the tour.
