Hello Everyone,

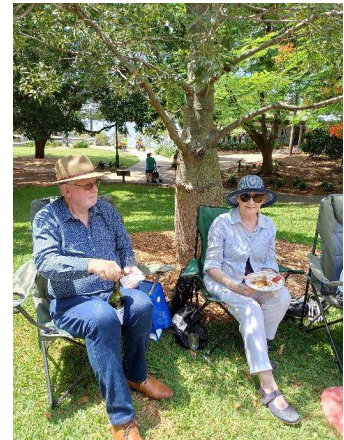
Here's wishing you all everything you wish for yourselves in 2026. Above all, good health, kind friends and good company.
