7.30am Depart Chermside. 8.30am Arrive Cleveland for barge boarding on ferry.9am Depart Cleveland. 10am Arrive at Stradbroke Island for morning tea.11am Scenic Drive around the island taking in Dunwich, Amity Point, Myora Springs and PointLookout. Drive past Deadmans and Cylinder beaches.
