On Tuesday 14 May the Federal Budget was handed down. The key issues for pensioners were:

- 1. A \$300 Electricity rebate. This applies to all households.
- 2. PBS prescriptions will remain at \$7.70 for the next 5 years
- 3. The deeming rate will remain at the current level for another year I am a bit worried in the way Mercer Super is administered. Recently I sent a message to them giving them 48 hours to transfer the balance of Lynley's account to me or I would lodge a complaint to APRA the regulator. Within one hour I received a phone call advising me that this would be sorted out. A few days later I get a letter that read "Leonie welcome to Mercer SmartRetirement Income and we confirm that we have now transferred the benefit of the late Mr Allan Issac into your account. The front of envelope did contain my correct address.

COST OF LIVING REBATE FOR SENIORS

I picked up a copy of the Seniors newspaper and read an article that there had been changes to the arrangement in regard to seniors receiving the cost-of-living rebate. The paper stated that seniors had to re-register to get this rebate. I rang the Seniors Office to seek clarification and was advised that the paper was going off hearsay and did not check with the Seniors Office in regard to validity of this before publishing. You do not have to re-register.
