## Ipswich Heritage Tour and Ipswich Little Theatre



After morning tea at Colleges Crossing we travel to Ipswich and meet our tour guide at the Ipswich Information Centre. We then take a guided bus tour of Ipswich.



The tour will finish at the Ipswich Little Theatre. This building was built as the Ipswich Incinerator. It was originally used to burn waste and opened in 1936 as the Ipswich Municipal Incinerator. The incinerator was eventually decommissioned and since 1969 has become the permanent home of The Ipswich Little Theatre group. It's also renowned for being the only building in Queensland designed by Walter Burley Griffin, who also designed the city of Canberra.



A light meal will be provided and a light-hearted play will be performed by their members.

The venue is wheelchair-accessible and includes a licenced bar. When paying please advise if you have any dietary requirements.
