President Pete opened the meeting at 11.00 am. The Guest Speaker, Russell Shelton was invited to give an account of the activities of the Marine Rescue Squad. Russell is the Commander of the Coffs Harbour Branch. He explained that "saving lives on the water, primarily to boating rescue" is the mission of the squad. If necessary, sea life will be assisted as well. This is a 24-hour selffunded operation which always needs volunteers who will be trained in whatever aspect of the search and recue profile they are comfortable to undertake; Crew, Radio, Auxiliary fund raising, and Administration are some examples. Vessels log on in each port advising number of people on board and time due home. Russell explained that boats in transit, not just local, are often assisted. Sponsors are needed and new volunteers are always welcome. Russell was excited at the prospect of a number of our members joining the squad.
