Construction began there in 1947 and the project lasted 34 years. Woomera became one of the most secret allied corporations in the Cold War and the population was up to 7,000 at that time. Gary spoke of many technical qualities of the procedures at Woomera and, on a lighter note, mentioned items prepared by the French Chef and the enjoyment of a great pool where one couldn't drown, only float.
