Tasha spoke on brief history of the Salvation Army. It opened 1865 as a pawn shop. In 1869, it was called the Volunteer Army, and 1885 finally changed its name to the Salvation Army. In 1880, it opened in Australia and now covers 153 countries. The main objective was to help those in need e.g. prisoners, welfare and general help to get people on their feet. Red Head matches were started as a fund raiser in later 1800s.

The "Sally" shop is mostly volunteers, who assist welfare recipients and accept donations of furniture, bric-a-brac, clothing. Everything is workable and clean.

The "Sally"s are always available is disasters and assist with alcohol and drug problems.
