Pete re-introduced Dr Alec McHarg to present a difficult topic - *Unravelling Western Society's Domestic Violence Dilemma*. Dr Alec's talk covered a multitude of sub-topics, including how "too much sugar causes the brain to jumble", hence setting off arguments. Dr Alec also highlighted how poverty is oftentimes a cause of DV, and how this has been exacerbated in recent years because it has been too easy to borrow money. Often this is highlighted by society's propensity to accept *Top Down* structures both in work and home situations, rather than *Bottom Up* structures where those at the workplace/home really understand the problems and too-often the real reasons for DV.
