Treasurer's Report 23rd September 2020 for period 1st – 31st August 2020

The National Seniors Forest Lake Cash Account for the period began with an opening balance of \$7,878.34, received income of \$750.00 incurred expenses of \$518.90 with a closing balance of \$8,109.44 made up as shown of:
