Here is a question for all of us more mature citizens; "What do we do when we can't remember our Bank and/or Credit Card numbers."

While talking to a neighbour recently who was trying to help her sister, who stays in North Queensland, pay an account, a worrying problem was raised. How can a relative or trusted friend help you when you can't remember your Bank Card or Credit Card number? The sister could not remember her card numbers any more, because of dementia. With the banks and card companies insisting on having 8 or 10 digit passwords with upper and lowercase letters, and at least one number and symbol, making the password difficult to break, and for us older people more difficult to remember.

This is a difficult problem to solve. The person holding your Power of Attorney is possibly the best person, if they are close by and freely available. With recent cases of carers, family members and "friends" being brought before the courts, for theft or fraud when an older person has allowed them access to their bank or credit cards, a person has to be super cautious and careful.

The one answer is to use the Public Trustee, but this can be expensive and is cumbersome to get things done.

I don't know what the answer is for you, but please be careful.

Branch Refund Policy

Cancellation of an outing

The branch policy for late cancellations. Notify the Secretary or Treasurer 48 hours beforehand. A Medical Certificate will be required to receive a refund if notification is 24 hours or less. In the case of a <u>sudden</u> medical emergency on the day which cannot be prevented, the Management Committee will consider the matter with respect to a refund.

When we have to book seats on a bus or give numbers for a booked luncheon and are still required to pay even in the case of a cancellation by a member a refund will not be provided. In the event of an activity/outing being cancelled due to some unforeseen circumstance beyond our control, eg: storm, transport breakdown, etc, and cannot be rescheduled, members will be refunded any monies paid.



On Friday 3 October our Treasurer Colin Court accepted a cheque/letter presented at the Heritage Bank Forest Lake. The purpose of the application was for the purchase of a laptop, wireless mouse and laptop bag. This will provide our Activities Coordinator with a computer to be used to organise the Branch's Event Calendar. The Activities Committee Team is Lynne Ball (Activities Coordinator), Pat Hetherington, Cheryl Williams and Julie Baldwin. Forest Lake One Community Ltd is administered in partnership with Heritage Bank Forest Lake Community Branch. Since 2005 Heritage has contributed over \$1.5 million to local community projects. Through this joint initiative, a portion of branch profits is reinvested into the local community. Forest Lake National Seniors have benefitted from the grants approved over the years. The Board of FLOC meets every second month to consider grant applications. Board members are all volunteers."
