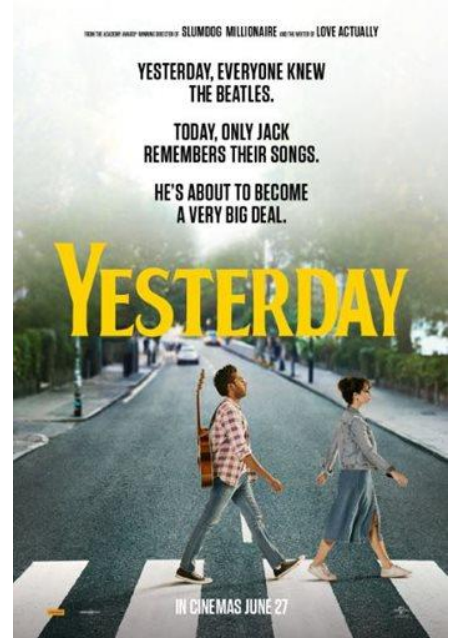
- **August 27 (Tues), 2019 Our AGM**
