'TUDORS to WINDSORS.' – British Royal Portraits from the 16th Century to the Present.

A Special Exhibition from the UK, from 16 March to 14 July at the Bendigo Art Gallery

'Tudors to Windsors' traces the history of the British monarchy through the outstanding collection of the National Portrait Gallery, London. The exhibition explores five royal dynasties: the Tudors, the Stuarts, the Georgians, the Victorians and the Windsors, shedding light on key figures and important historical moments. To bring these royal figures to life, Bendigo Art Gallery has secured key loans of historic fashion, armour and personal effects which will be featured alongside these magnificent and imposing portraits.

The tour takes 90 mins to 2 hours; Cost Adults \$25; Concession \$22.

We will need to book a time slot for viewing that will be suitable for us, and to the Gallery. It takes about 2 hours on the train to Bendigo (use your free tickets) or we could hire a bus. Lunch Venue: to be advised.
